GIANT FLOOR MAP OF MISSISSIPPI COMING TO THE MUSEUM OF THE MISSISSIPPI DELTA

Students will be exploring Mississippi a big way – with a giant floor map of the state. The map, measuring 10 feet by 15 feet is designed as a geo-game board to introduce students to the power of maps and the diverse geography of Mississippi. The map's brightly colored, smooth vinyl surface accurately illustrates physical geography (ecological regions, rivers), political geography (counties, cities), and enhances mapping skills (cardinal directions, scale). The map includes major cities, railroads, rivers and fun, hands-on activities that enrich geography, science, and social studies learning. Students can explore Mississippi's water resources, blues history, natural resources, Native American cultures, and transportation and the economy, among other topics.
